OVERVIEW

Designed for educators in their first three years of teaching, this coaching program addresses concerns ranging from classroom management strategies, time management, administrative support, and burnout. This program provides practical advice and strategies for educators as they get started in their teaching careers.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

A cohort of 3-6 teachers join the program to receive specialized skills and training.

- Access to the online TeachUNITED course
- One-on-one coaching from a TeachUNITED coach
- Community-building webinars and workshops

They will have opportunities to learn and practice new strategies, reflect with peer teachers on their growth, and share practical tools for success.
